Press Release

'Residents for the Future of Fair Haven' calls upon Borough Council to arrange for visual impact analysis at Christ Methodist Church site.

Fair Haven, NJ, May 7, 2007 – In a prior press release, the 'Residents for the Future of Fair Haven' (RFFoFH) reported the results of its analysis which concluded that **no** location in the Borough of Fair Haven meets the acceptable ranges of the criteria, other than Fair Haven Fields. RFFoFH is growing concerned with the ongoing discussions between the Borough and the Christ Methodist Church. In particular, it wants to have a firm understanding of the visual impact that could result from a cell tower located at that site. It is calling upon the Mayor and the Council of the Borough of Fair Haven to arrange for a test similar to the crane test that was done at the Nativity Church site last summer. The request is for either a crane or a balloon to be located as close as possible to the target location for the cell tower and at the same height as the proposed cell tower. RFFoFH feels that this is only way that the impact on this site can be assessed.

About 'Residents for the Future of Fair Haven'

The 'Residents for the Future of Fair Haven' (RFFoFH) is a group committed to sponsoring and supporting initiatives that are of importance to the Borough and its residents. RFFoFH has joined with Borough Officials and state legislators in the Assembly supporting an application before the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) for a land diversion that would permit a cell tower to be located in Fair Haven Fields. RFFoFH maintains a website (<http://www.fair-haven.com/celltower>) that keeps residents informed of ongoing developments regarding the cell tower. It also maintains a mailing list that numbers almost 500 Borough residents, and continues to grow. It has sponsored petition drives and several email letter campaigns that have demonstrated significant public support behind the Borough Council's initiative in this matter. RFFoFH plans over time to become involved in other activities within the Borough, and to support government officials that are aligned with its interests.
